Background:

1. Controversy about PSA screening

Patient Factors:

1. Life expectancy assessment and comorbidities
2. PSA result and derivatives (Free/Total, etc.)
3. Family history
4. Risk calculator results (SWOP, PCPT 2.0, etc.)

Evaluation Options:

1. Further biomarker evaluation
 - a. PSA free/total, 4K score, liquid biopsy, PCA3, etc.
2. Multiparametric MRI of prostate
3. Prostate Biopsy
